

LIVE AUCTION RULES

1. Raising your bid card and being recognized by the auctioneer enters a bid.
2. All bids are considered to be a binding commitment to purchase. The auctioneer has the right to reject any bid that, in the opinion of the auctioneer, is not commensurate with the value of the item being offered.
3. The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer shall be the purchaser. In the event, of a dispute among bidders, the auctioneer shall have the sole and final discretion either to determine the successful bidder or to re-offer and re-sell the article in dispute.
4. When the auctioneer announces the item as "SOLD", the highest bidder becomes legally obligated to complete the purchase of the item or services and thereupon assumes full risk and responsibility for payment thereafter.
5. Any item not sold at a satisfactory price may be withdrawn at the discretion of the auctioneer.
6. Payment must be made by cash, check, MasterCard, Visa, or American Express. Checks must be made payable to "Global Lyme Alliance".
7. All sales are final, there will be no exchanges/refunds on items except where specified. All items and services are donated and are being sold "as is". Global Lyme Alliance makes no warranties and/or representation whatsoever, with respect to such items and services. Dates and locations of events are subject to change. In this event, Global Lyme Alliance will do its best to accommodate the purchaser but will not produce refunds.
8. Unless otherwise specified, all auction items and services must be redeemed no later than October 10, 2019.
9. All Live Auction items purchased must be removed on the evening of the auction by the purchaser. At the time any item is paid in full, the purchaser will be issued a "paid" receipt from the check-out desk and will receive the item.
10. The check-out table for live auction items will open at 10:00 p.m. or when the announced by the host.
